Glasgow Presbytery Youth Representative

The youth representative would serve for one Presbytery session, from September 2016 to June 2017, attending Presbytery meetings monthly (currently held on Tuesday evenings at 7pm). The youth representatives would also be co-opted onto the Learning and Nurture Committee and expected to attend meetings monthly (currently Tuesdays 6pm). Youth reps would also ideally attend CoSY Glasgow events where possible, to engage with wider youth in Glasgow and share what's happening at a Presbytery level.

CoSY Glasgow Coordinator

The CoSY Glasgow Coordinator would serve for one Presbytery session, from September 2016 to June 2017. They would be co-opted onto the Learning and Nurture Committee and expected to attend meetings monthly (currently Tuesdays 6pm). The CoSY Glasgow Coordinator would be responsible for coordinating CoSY Glasgow meetings or wider events, making attempt to engage more young people than those who've attended National Youth Assembly or General Assembly, working with Karen Wallace, the Youth Development Coordinator for Glasgow Presbytery.
